Business Intelligence Center Advisory Board Meeting

June 7, 2021, 11:00 am

1. Welcome and thanks from Secretary

Welcome and thanks from Secretary Griswold at 11:04 AM.

2. Board member introductions

3. Roles and responsibilities for board members

Mike Hardin provided information to the board members on the Business Intelligence Center (BIC) as it is written in statute, Section 24-21-116, and the purpose of the BIC. Mike Hardin also provided information on Section 24-3.7-102, C.R.S Statutory Requirements for Creation of Boards and Commissions. - Mike Ferrufino suggested a number of data points that would be useful to the board including, the number of participants, how outreach has been conducted to reach Colorado's young and diverse population.
- Secretary Griswold suggested reaching out to resources to enhance the experience of competitors by building relationships with venture capital groups.
- Rehan Hasan provided historical context about the outreach and goal for reaching a diverse group of Coloradans to participate in Go Code Colorado.
- Christopher Beall identified to the Board that one of the goals is to move the Go Code Challenge in a direction that they will identify and to expand the diversity of the program

Christopher Beall asked if board members could come together sometime after July 4th to brainstorm the direction of the Go Code competition in the future. Board members agreed and a meeting will be scheduled in the coming weeks.
